The match has now been approved as an International Level 3 match.

This was the biggest match ever held outside of a National Championships and it was as a result of some very hard work by a small band of very hard working people. A big thank you to all of the Range Officers and Stats people who endured some very hot weather and still managed to get the jobs done. For some it was their first taste of a big match and hopefully it will spur them along into attending a lot more matches in the future.
