

# IPSC VICTORIA/TASMANIA

## Team Selection Criteria

The following are the requirements to be included in the Victorian State Teams to contest the National Championships.

- The number of Selection matches held determines the minimum requirement for a person who wishes to be considered for Team Selection. If there are 4 or 5 matches, then the three best scores will be averaged to determine your position in the standings. More or less matches will have more or less minimum requirements; this will be determined by the State Executive.
- The State Titles match is a compulsory match requirement. The score from this match is not a mandatory count, but will be used if it is in the range of the 'best' score requirement.
- Failure to attend sufficient matches will mean that you have not performed the minimum requirement and will not be counted as a prospective Team Member.
- Prospective Team members who feel they have been left out of a Team due to insufficient match attendances, and wish to apply to the State Executive for an adjudication, are required to write to the Section Coordinator prior to the next State Executive meeting immediately after they are out of contention due to lack of match attendance, detailing the reasons why they should still be considered for inclusion in a Team at the expense of someone who has completed the requirement. Supporting information must be provided in their letter. Failure to attend Selection matches because they were too far away or equipment problems will not be considered valid reasons.
- There is no requirement to register to be considered for a Team position.
- All Team members will be required to pay their own entry fee and Presentation Dinner fee and will be reimbursed after the Championships. All designated Gold Team members should consider attendance at the Presentation Dinner a requirement. Failure to attend the Presentation Dinner will result in no refund for that cost. Only the Championship 'Early Bird' entry fee will be refunded in any case.
- This list is not exhaustive and may be amended by the Executive as required.
