Previous Meeting Minutes

Matters Arising

- Minutes corrections
 - VPPPC attended meeting not VPPC
- State Team Shirts (Treasurer)
 - To update designs of the shirts and present at the next meeting.
- IPSCVT Secure Website Login (Section Coordinator)
 - Motion that a secure area for the IPSC Vic/ Tas website be arranged as per November 2014 minutes.
 - Moved CS Seconded WDPC To be reviewed at January 2015 meeting.
- SSM & State Titles Match Entry Proposal (Treasurer)
 - Sale PC spoke on their selection match experience and the additional time it takes for members to prepare and run and the overall ROI to the club in running a SSM.
 - MVPC indicated verbally that they would support a \$10 rise in annual fee's but do not support any further increases.
 - An alternate Match Entry Proposal was received from PPLA for consideration.
 - General discussions with all delegates were had surrounding the proposals tabled. It was agreed the Treasurer would collate all information and provide the final proposal for discussion at the January 2015 meeting.
- 2015/2016 Selection & State Titles Match Schedule (Section Coordinator)
 - WDPC advised that they would like to run a SSM next year – 1st preference is October 2015.
 - OPC indicated that they would like to run a SSM, however jacketed rounds may no longer be used on any of their ranges. IPSCVT (GMoon) to provide a letter to OPC indicating the SSM entry can say that jacketed rounds may not be used in the match so the delegate may present to the OPC Committee.

- Sale PC advised that they would like to run a SSM – 1st preference 14/15 November, 2nd preference 21/22 November 2015.
- Van Diemen PC would like to run the 2015 Tasmanian State Titles as a Level 3 on 31 October/ 1 November 2015 in Launceston. It was indicated that they would require support from interstate Range Officers.
- WHGC – SC to confirm that WDHC would like to host a SSM in September 2015 and confirm the dates.

State selection matches dates & the 2016 Victorian State Titles & venues to be confirmed at the January 2015 meeting.

- Karla Blowers attendance at 2015 State Titles (Section Coordinator/Treasurer)
 - It was reported that Karla was pleased to receive the congratulations and recognition from IPSCVT. The Treasurer advised that Karla is very keen to attend the match however this is dependent on her university timetable. She will advise the Treasurer as soon as she can.
- State Titles Perpetual Trophy (Section Coordinator)
 - Motion that the Victorian State Titles Trophy be renamed the Brodie McIntosh Trophy in honor of his achievements in the sport.
 - Moved GPC Seconded OPC Motion Carried
 - SC to send Brodie McIntosh a letter requesting the renaming of the trophy.
- Chronograph (Section Coordinator/ Treasurer)
 - SC presented costing's for the chronograph from db-shooting supplies of \$300.
 - Motion that the SC get comparable quotes for the chronograph including the bag, 240v battery and infrared and purchase at the cheapest quote. This will travel with the NROI delegate from match to match.

Reports

Section Coordinator

- SC indicated that the other states are trying to get over calibre in their states and have requested a copy of the Victorian submission. SC provided to RD.
- SC brought to the attention of the delegates the Victoria Police media release surrounding that social media use of pictures and video's with handguns and asked that this information be relayed to all club members.
- SC advised that SZiccone is in hospital - best wishes were sent from IPSCVT.

Special Projects

- A number of queries have been received on the classic submission. GMoon advised that during the 3 days spent at the SSAA meeting in Queensland, the SSAA have intent to present IPSC as an over-calibre event in the NFA.
- Advised that he has been tasked to do a constitutional review for IPSC Victoria; requested that the club delegates review and provide feedback - areas for consideration; voting rights; relationship with Tasmania; number of votes per club per membership; number of proxy's/ delegates an individual can hold. Secretary to provide a copy of the current constitution with the December minutes as a separate document which delegates can distribute within their club for feedback. Feedback should be returned to IPSCVT by the end of February 2015.

Club Reports

- GPC – held a successful Christmas shoot and function last week.
- SPC - still recovering from SSM – Christmas shoot scheduled for next weekend.
- VPPPC – Christmas shoot was held last weekend with a few visitors from PPLA.
- WDPC – Christmas shoot next Sunday 21/12.
- SSPC – Christmas shoot next Thursday 18/12.
- Calibre – New range at Broadford finally up and running. Successful Christmas and first match held last weekend with only a few teething problems.
CS extended an open invitation to all delegates and their club members to attend any of CS matches.
- OPC – New Club Captain is Steve S; OPC is closed until 12 January 2015; OPC advised that there is not a club appointed second delegate for IPSC. They will advise as soon as one is appointed; OPC indicated that they are willing & keen to run a super Sunday in May 2015 - 3 weeks before the Nationals.
- WHGC – The meeting was advised that WHGC were currently under threat with bushfires.
- CPC – Christmas Fun Shoot & BBQ – 20/12.
- MISC – AGM held in November, almost all new committee members.

- PPLA – hosted rifle shotgun nationals several weeks ago, a good match and reasonably well attended. The SC thanked PPLA and in particular SZiccone for his work and the tireless efforts of the members that helped put the match together and run; Christmas match Sunday 21/12 all welcome – match entry \$20 includes lunch; State titles match package is waiting for sanctioning and will be posted on the IPSCVT website two week prior to the match.

It was noted that as per the IPSCVT constitution the IPSCVT club delegates must approve all State Titles Matches – it was requested that the match package be emailed to all delegates and feedback be provided directly to PPLA prior to Christmas.

The PPLA delegate brought to the attention of the delegates that a member of PPLA had proposed that Steel Challenge be run at PPLA in the fifth weekend of March 2015.

General discussion was had surrounding the Steel Challenge match and it was noted that it is owned by SSAA and does not have a structure for holster qualification.

- Moved that IPSCVT facilitate the Steel Challenge and that support with IPSCVT RO's if required for the match at PPLA.
- Moved WDPC Seconded GPC Motion Carried.

It was noted that the Rifle shotgun match scheduled for that weekend at PPLA is not the IPSCVT state titles rifle shotgun match.

General Business

- GPC asked that consideration be given to invite Brodie McIntosh to be apart of the Gold Open Victorian State Team based on his performance at the recent world shoot to assist with the bolstering of the Gold Team results. GPC asked that delegates discuss with their clubs and provide comments at the January 2015 meeting.
- WHGC queried whether a club could charge for a holster qualification. It was agreed that this was at the discretion of the club.
- GMoon advised that from 1 January 2015 – Juniors are classified in IPSC as those under 18 years of age.
- IPSC Monthly meetings - it was agreed that the meetings would be scheduled for 2015 on the third Monday of each month and the time would be brought forward to 7:30pm.
