- Section Coordinator
  - IPSCA AGM report
    - The SC spoke to his written report of his attendance at the IPSC Australia AGM. A copy of the report is attached to these minutes.
- Treasurer
  - Written report submitted - moved that the report be accepted.

- NROI
  - Report presented by GMoon
    - SSM 2 over the weekend went well. Only just had sufficient RO's to cover the match. Four DQ's – one for breaking 90 and 3 for sweeping.
    - NROI expressed his thanks to all those RO's that worked.
    - Date for the RO course has been confirmed – Saturday 4/ Sunday 5 December venue to be confirmed. All attendees must be members of IPSC.
    - Delegates are reminded to advise NROI delegate of those who wish to attend from their clubs by the first week of November so pre-course work can be sent.
- Special Projects
  - SC has advised that until the IPSC Australia constitution has been reviewed and updated that all work on the IPSCVT constitution should but put on hold.
  - SC requested that GMoon spend more time on the review and development of match packages for the SSM's and State Titles. SC has requested that GMoon work with AMoss on this project. Both GMoon and AMoss agreed.
- Club Reports
  - PPLA – slightly smaller club comp than normal - 5 stages, 60 competitors. Next month match will be usual 3<sup>rd</sup> Sunday (week after SSM3). PPLA will be holding Victorian Steel Challenge in May 2016 and Rifle Shotgun will be in October in the fifth weekend in 2016.
  - WHGC –
  - CPC – held holster & grading tests during the month in conjunction with MISC.
  - MISC – held holster & grading tests during the month in conjunction with CPC. One of these newly accredited members attended SSM2 and performed well.
  - SSPC – new committee appointed at AGM held during the month.
  - VPPPC – AGM held during the month - no change in committee. Currently doing some works on their range.
  - OPC – opened the books and some new members have joined. OPC have now deemed that if you are not a VAPA member you are not permitted to shoot at the range (competition or practice).  
Current legal action pending - a non-shooting related injury occurred three years ago and legal action has commenced this year.  
OPC has requested a copy of the IPSC insurance policy from the SC.  
Currently looking at upgrading some of the ranges to suit IPSC.  
New process at OPC - visitors visits are now capped at 10 visits per year per individual.
  - SPC – SSM4 entry form has been published. SPC would like a standard entry form for all SSM and State titles. Secretary will create a template.

## General Business

- o Discussion was had surrounding how IPSC Vic could support those clubs hosting state selection matches.

Motion that IPSCVT, on an annual basis donate IPSCVT funds to be used for equipment (such as swingers, poppers, bases, plates) based on a request for assistance from the clubs hosting State Selection Matches on an ongoing basis. Submissions from Clubs should be received by the end of May each year for review by the Delegates at a section meeting.

- o Motion that for 2015, SPC are requested to submit a request for assistance for their SSM for approval by the SC.

- o The SC has had requests from interstate competitors requesting access to the IPSCVT website. It was agreed unanimously that only Victorian/ Tasmanian IPSC members should have access to the IPSCVT website.

- o The SC reported that Victoria has been awarded the 2016 Shotgun Nationals. It was unanimously agreed that GMoon and AMoss be appointed the coordinators for course design and PPLA will host the match in October 2016.

- o The SC reported that the 2017 Handgun Nationals would be held at Pine Valley PC in Western Australia. The 2018 Handgun Nationals are yet to be decided but will be allocated either to NSW or Victoria.

- o Based on requests from SSM2, GMoon reminded Clubs and Delegates that pre matches are for range officers, match officials, sponsors, and patrons only. Competitors are not permitted to participate in pre matches under any circumstance.

- o Discussion was had surrounding IPSCVT's affiliation to the CFCV. An invoice was submitted for affiliation for consideration.

Motion that IPSCVT be affiliated with the CFCV and the annual fee be paid immediately.
