

IPSC Victoria Representative Team Selection Process



1 Representative Team Purpose

The selection of state Gold Teams for Victoria will be focused on performance. Silver Teams will be considered for each Division to support the development of upcoming competitors.

2 Team Selection Process

- The State team selection results will be published after each Level 3 Selection match.
- A division or category must be recognised at that match to be included in the competitor results, (10 competitors for a division, and 5 for a category if the Division is recognised)
- If a category or division is not recognised at 3 or more of the selection matches, the category or division will not be eligible for State Team or Representation.
- At the end of the selection period, the teams are finalised based on the team selection criteria, any errors or omissions should be identified in line with the grievance process.
- The average of each competitor's top three scores from the State Selection Matches is used to rank
 the eligible competitors, and the competitors are selected for teams in descending average order
 from these rankings.

OR

A current Division Grand Master may be offered a position in the team of this division

3 Teams

3.1 Division teams

A member of each Division Gold team is appointed by the Section Coordinator (with advice from the assembled delegates) as the Division captain. The Captain's accountabilities include:

- Represent the team at presentation post-match:
 - receive any team award
 - co-ordinate team for photo

3.1.1 Gold

- if there are 3 or more competitors available for selection, and the sum of the top 3 competitors average results is greater than 250%, the team is submitted

3.1.2 Silver

The submission of a Silver team is not dependent on a Gold team being submitted to the match.

- if there are 3 or more competitors available for selection, and the sum of top 3 competitors average result is greater than 200%, the team is submitted
- the fourth member of a Silver team must have a qualifying average percentage of greater than (or equal to) 50%

3.1.3 Category teams

- if there are at least 3 competitors and the sum of their average results is > 150%

3.2 Representatives

3.2.1 Division

If there is no team submitted for division, the highest placed competitor in the division will be submitted as the state representative, if their (best three score) average percentage is greater than 70% (Agrade)

3.2.2 Category

If there is no team submitted for a category, the highest placed competitor in the category will be

submitted as the state category representative, if their (best three score) average percentage is greater than 40% (C-grade)

3.3 Selection Tie-break

If two or more competitors eligible for selection are tied on average result, their results of the eligible state titles will be used to establish their position.

If their results from the state titles are also tied, the State Executive will vote (with one vote per club) on the eligible competitors

3.4 Competitor Eligibility

- Must be a current financial member of IPSC Australia
- Must be affiliated with an IPSC Victoria club (or be cleared by the Section Coordinator of their affiliated section)
- Must have entered in the Victorian State Titles
- Must have competed in 66% of eligible selection matches (rounded up to the nearest whole number) in the division they wish to be considered for selection
- Must not have been disqualified under rules from either section 10.6 or 10.7 during any of the eligible selection matches (and the disqualification is upheld if arbitrated)
- Must not have been disqualified from more than one of the eligible selection matches under any rule
- During the selection period, if a competitor has brought the State into disrepute through their actions or inactions, this may be considered by the delegates in the selection process

4 Exceptions

4.1 Special Considerations

Competitors can submit a request for special consideration to the Section Coordinator in writing, prior to the nominated Section meeting for team selection

- this request is reviewed by the IPSC Victoria delegates on an individual basis
- all decisions made by the delegates are final and must not be taken as a precedent

4.2 Grievance

Any grievance must be submitted in writing to the Section Coordinator, to be presented to the delegates for resolution at the next Section meeting.

5 Remuneration / Re-imbursement

Each team member receives the following:

- one Team Victoria cap, to be worn while competing during the Nationals
- three Team Victoria shirts to be worn while competing (personalised, with the competitor's name and representative position)

In addition, Gold Team members receive the following:

- entry fees (equal to the early bird entry fee)
- presentation dinner ticket

Each division team captain receives the following:

- Additional cash re-imbursement of \$100

The highest placed Victorian team member in the final results from the Nationals in each Division receives the following:

- Additional cash re-imbursement of \$100

Re-imbursements are made to the competitors after the completion of their obligations (attendance, performance, captain's duties).
